NJ EMERGENCY MEDICAL DISPATCHER (EMD)

The Emergency Medical Dispatcher (EMD) is the principle link between the public in need of emergency medical assistance and the EMS system. This course is 32 hours, you will be learning about the responsibility of the EMS system, legal aspects, interpersonal communications, giving medical instructions by telephone, resource allocation, use of emergency medical guide cards. Course includes a day and a half of role-play and simulations involving 911 calls. After successful completion of this course students will have the fundamentals to start handling 911 calls that are medical in nature, and will be qualified to work in any 911 dispatch center in New Jersey.

Prerequisites for the EMD course are: A valid Healthcare Provider (or equivalent) CPR card, & certification as a Tele-communicator
